



Hardin ISD 2020-2023 ESSER III Uses of Funds Plan

Pre-Award:

\$0 will be charged as pre-award costs for activities that occurred between March 13, 2020 and June 28, 2021.

Loss of Learning – 20% Required Set-Aside:

\$394,623 will be expended to meet the 20% minimum required set-aside for learning loss mitigation. The following interventions will be implemented to address the academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students, particularly those students disproportionately impacted by the pandemic.

- The LEA will provide after school tutorials for students in grades PK-12 to mitigate learning loss throughout the 2021-2022 school year.
- Summer school and a summer reading program will be offered to students in grades PK-12 to mitigate learning loss during the summer of 2022.
- The LEA will address reading and math learning loss for students in grades PK-12 through evidence-based activities including intervention and reading on-line programs during the 2021-2022 school year, including the summer of 2022.
- Staff will attend reading professional development.
- Campus counselors and an At-Risk counselor will provide mental health and support services to address the social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students.

\$1,578,490 will be expended for the following activities during the following years.
